

Find out your ring size

Method 1

Take a ring that fits you or a ring that fits the person you're giving a gift. Measure it with a ruler inside the diameter of the ring. Keep in mind every millimeter to determine the exactly size of the ring.

Multiply the diameter in millimeters with 3.14 and you will get the circumference length, which is indicated on the ring size, on our page, SilverZone.eu.

For instance: You established that your ring diameter measured with the ruler on the inside is 18 mm.

$18 \text{ mm} \times 3.14 = 56.52$, that means the size you need is 57.

If you established that your ring diameter on the inside is 16 mm.

$16 \text{ mm} \times 3.14 = 50.24$, that means the size you need is 50.



Method 2

Cut a narrow strip of paper. Apply the tape around the base of your finger. Mark with a pen the place where the paper close the circumference (where the paper overlap). Measure the length in millimeters of the portion of the band formed around the circumference of your finger.

Your ring size is the length of the circumference of the ring, in millimeters.
